

Preparing Soil for Carrots

If you have terrible soil for growing carrots, here's an easy way to get long straight carrots without struggling to change the soil of an entire plot.

Step 1: Thoroughly water an area so that it loosens up enough for some digging.

Step 2: Take a hoe or flat-edged shovel and dig a trench about 4 inches wide and 9–10 inches deep.

Step 3: Fill trenches with a soil mixture of half sand and half mulch.

Step 4: Plant carrot seeds making sure to water often to prevent drying out. If you have limited garden space, use a container filled with soil.
