Crawford FFA Livestock Show General Rules

1. Show date will be: October 25, 2014
2. The show will be open to all FFA and 4-H members.
3. All entries should be mailed by: October 20, 2014. Entries may be made on the day of the show, but no entries will be accepted after 9:00 A.M, the day of the show. **NO LATE ENTRY CHARGE.**
4. Entries must be in place by 9:00 A.M.
5. Additional classes may be arranged at the discretion of the show officials if a sufficient number of entries are made.
6. Birthdays must be included on the entries of all breeding beef cattle and **you will need registration papers** at check in.
7. Ewe lambs will be allowed to enter the prospect lamb show.
8. Gilts will be allowed to enter the prospect pig show (no boar pigs over 125 lbs.)
9. No pigs over 200 lbs.
10. Ribbons will be awarded in each of the divisions.
11. A showmanship class will be available for entry the day of the show. A belt buckle will go to the winner of each division. (Steers, heifer, pig, meat goat, and lamb.)
12. NO bedding of any type is allowed in the barn or on the fair grounds. (please feed hay from a bag or outside) Each exhibitor shall keep the premises clean at all times. Washing facilities and electrical outlets will be available. Beef cattle will be shown with the hair down. (no glue) Clipping of livestock will be allowed on the show grounds. No animals will be allowed on the fairgrounds until 6:30 A.M on the day of the show.
13. Any entry found to be diseased shall be removed from the show grounds.
14. Entries will not be refunded.
15. All placing and result are final.
16. Entry fees will be as follows: \$ 10.00 for all divisions
17. Schedule: 6:30 am- animals start arriving
7:30 a.m-9:00 a.m- all animals weighed- checked in
9:00 a.m- all animals in place
9:00 a.m- rabbit show
10:00 a.m- heifer show followed by steer show
10:00 a.m- goat show followed by lamb show
10:30 a.m- pig show
