

DOG TRAINING

INTRODUCTION TO NOSE WORK

(LIMITED TO 6 DOGS)

The goal of this class is to have fun with your dog. It will be a learning game of hunting with your dog. All dogs will work one at a time, and will be required to be crated during the other dog's working turn. It is easier if your dog already has a strong desire to want to play with toys but it is not required in order to take the class. This is a good class for rescue dogs that need to build confidence; a dog that needs to be more confident in different surroundings or for a dog that can become less confident in a class with lots of other dogs. Since each dog and handler will work on at a time, the dog will be able to gain confidence while using both mental and physical stimulation around obstacles and in different surroundings without stressing over having to interact with other dogs.

Restrictions: Dogs must be crate-trained. Dogs must be able to be confined in a crate during class either away from the handler or crated in their vehicle with proper ventilation and weather permitting.

You will need a crate, chair, flat or buckle or Martingale style collar or a properly fitted harness, (no step in harnesses, head halters, easy walk harnesses or sensation leads, choke chains or prong collars -- except when coming into and leaving the search area if needed) 6-12 foot light-weight leather leash (all tags, charms and poop bag holders must be removed from leash), bait bag or "Tug N Treat" to put treats in (no plastic bags) You will also need treats and/or toys that must be high value to your dog! Bring toys your dogs plays with or obsesses over not toys your dog shows little interest in. Treats should be their favorite treats not just okay treats. Bring several different items so that you can have a another choice if what you thought would work, does not. If you have an active dog that is high energy, please do not run them hard or wear them out before this class. Dogs must be vaccinated current and have proof of current Rabies vaccination.

**Any handlers under 16 years of age must have a parent/guardian present during class.

** Please do not feed your dog before the class so that your dog is hungry and motivated. Do not use the dog's daily kibble as a form of treat.

**Always wear comfortable non-skid shoes when training your dog. Preferably closed toe & no heels.

**Always bring water for your dog and a spray bottle on warmer days.

**No chain or retractable leads in or around training areas.

**No dogs with aggression towards other dogs that the handler cannot control.

**No dogs with aggression towards people allowed in classes.

**Where it is mentioned you need leash, training collar, harness, dog treats, bait bag, etc.; these items will be available for purchase in the Pawformance store on site.
