Central Texas Big Buck Contest

Contest Rules

1. All archery, youth and general season hunters are eligible for all prizes. Entry Deadlines: Archery Season—Sept. 30th; Youth Season—October 28th; General Season—November 4th.
2. Entry fee is \$25.00. All hunters will receive a cap.
3. Bucks taken must be reported within 72 hours to be scored.
4. Two bucks may be scored but only one buck can be entered.
5. Scoring Deadline: Midnight January 3rd, 2012. You must contact Todd Clift at 254-707-3015 to have the deer scored the next day if the deer was taken the day of the deadline.
6. Measurement Location: **Clifton Feed & Service Center** at Hwy 219 in Clifton.
7. The Whitetail deer must be taken in the following counties: Bosque, Coryell, Erath, Hamilton, Hill, Johnson, McLennan or Somervell.
8. Bucks killed within a deer-proof fence area are not eligible to win a prize.
9. Bucks must be properly tagged according to Texas State Game Law when brought in for measurement. Hunters must also have a valid hunting license.
10. Any contestant may be required to take a Polygraph test. Failure to take a polygraph test will result in disqualification.
11. Any hunter found trying to cheat is automatically disqualified and barred from entering this contest for a period of time to be determined by the contest committee.
12. Any registered hunter found guilty of violation Texas Game Laws automatically forfeits his or her chance of winning any prize.
13. All prizes must be used by July 31, 2012.
14. All decisions of the contest committee are final.

Scoring System

1. Number of points
2. Inside spread
3. Longest tine from main beam
4. Measurement of both bases
5. Longest main beam
6. Tie Breaker will be as follows—Number of points, inside spread, longest tine from main beam, measurement of both bases, longest main beam, and finally, coin flip.
 - A. Number of Points—no points will be counted that are less than 1 inch from the base. Points between the brow tine and the base will not be counted.
 - B. Inside Spread of Main Beam— is measured at a right angle to the centerline of the widest point between main beams.
 - C. Longest Tine from Main Beam—Will be the longest tine measured from its base off the main beam.
 - D. Measurement of both Bases—Measurement of the right and left horn bases will be calculated between base and the first point.
 - E. Longest Main Beam—The length of the main beam is measured from the outside edge of the base to the tip on the main beam. The line of measurement will go along the outside of the horn. The measurement will start on the back of the base of the horn.
 - F. All measurements will be rounded to the closest 1/8th inch.
 - G. If any part of the horn is broken off then the detached portion will not be eligible to be measured.
