Medical/Liability Release:

Each participant is required to complete a medical/liability release form that must be notarized. Please mail or turn in the release form with your Registration Monies to Rainey's Feed & Hardware attention Chloe Ellis, 4865 Hwy 234 White City, Or. 97503. This is an absolute necessity and must be completed before anyone can participate. NO RELEASE FORM, NO CLINIC!

Clinic Outline:

Each morning you should have your steers washed and ready to go at the barn by 9 am.

Saturday- We will cover equipment, cleaning, and after lunch, clipping.

(Saturday from 6:00 pm—8:00 pm we will have Pizza and Nutrtion this will be open to everyone in the community.)

Sunday- Show fitting will start promptly, followed by showmanship. After lunch the focus will be on Nutrition.

Equipment You Need To Bring:

• Suggested clippers: Andis 2-speeds, beef head or hair head.

Example: Andis HC clipper.

- \cdot Suggested blades: Super Blocking or Blocking blade, T-84 blade, Medium Blending blade, HT 5/8 blade.
- · Notepad and pen for notes.
- Things you might want to bring include clippers, show stick, blower and a chute
- You are encouraged to bring your own animal to the clinic. Bringing your own animal is to your advantage because we can help highlight that steer/heifer's specific strengths.
