

# Green Tree

FrogHyla cinerea

**Distribution:** Southeastern U.S.A.

**Size:** 1.5" - 2.5"

**Natural habitat:** This arboreal species inhabits grassland and mixed woodland habitats near pond and stream areas. Adults require a 10 gallon enclosure for proper captive care.

**Behavior:** Most will become tame with regular handling. Always wash your hands after handling this frog. Likes to climb through dense foliage areas.

**Captive environment:** Use full spectrum lighting 12-14 hours per day. Use low light only, this species is mostly nocturnal. Provide dense foliage for climbing.

**Temperature:** Maintain day temperature range between 76-82 degrees F. Maintain night temperature range between 70-75 degrees F. Use a low wattage heat lamp in well ventilated enclosure.

**Humidity :** This species requires moderate to high levels of humidity.

**Water requirements:** Provide a large shallow bowl for drinking and soaking. Mist the enclosure daily for moisture and high humidity. Use only dechlorinated water.

**Nutritional requirements:** This species eats bugs. Always offer variety for proper nutrition. Dust food with calcium & vitamins. Crickets and wax worms are enjoyed.
