

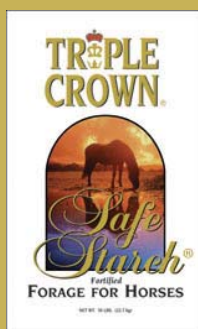
Triple Crown Safe Starch Formula

A number of factors make it difficult and often impossible to determine the actual NSC value of their horses's diet: 1) They only get hay in small batches - so even if the hay is tested, by the time they have the results the hay has changed and so has the NSC%. 2) They get the hay tested and it comes back high in NSC but it is their only supply option. 3) They board so they no control over the hay source their horse receives. The product is 6% fat and contains the EqiMix technology found in all Triple Crown feeds. Feeding Directions

Triple Crown Safe Starch Forage is an all in one diet for mature horses. No other hay, pasture, or mineral and vitamin supplement is required to provide your horse a complete and balanced diet. Feed Triple Crown Safe Starch Forage to mature horses at a rate that maintains desired body condition. Begin with approximately 2% of body weight (20 pounds for a 1000 pound horse) and adjust up or down, depending upon the individual horse's body condition. You want to feed a minimum of 1% of body weight. Provide access to salt and fresh, clean water at all times.
